UNIFORM POLICY



Rationale:

The College Council has developed the Uniform Policy as set out below. All students are expected to respect the rules. If this is not possible, students are asked to provide a note to the office at the start of the day if they are out of uniform for any reason. Temporary uniform items should be as similar as possible to uniform (same or close colour). Students who wear inappropriate items may be asked to remove them and wear an item of second-hand uniform.

Aims:

- To provide clear directions regarding the wearing of the school uniform
- To positively promote the school's image to the wider community

Implementation:

- This policy will be active from Term 3 2017. A transition of 18 months applies with the change in policy. By the start of 2019, all students must be in a navy school polo, and boys must have navy shorts/pants with the school logo. Students will also be required to wear the Murtoa College jacket if they wish to wear a coat. During the 18-month transition students may wear a navy or black jacket in the yard but not in class.
- This policy forms part of, and is to be read in conjunction with, the school's jewellery and UV radiation policies.

PRIMARY

Girls Uniform

- Black shoes, these may be elastic sided boots, all black runners or traditional school shoes
- Sports shoes should be brought for PE and sport lessons

Summer:

- Blue and white checked cotton dress or navy short-sleeved polo shirt (white stripes around collar), with school logo and navy shorts.
- Bucket hat in terms 1 and 4

Winter:

- Navy track pants or tailored skirt, navy long sleeved polo shirt (white stripes around collar) with school logo.
- White or navy skivvy.
- Navy bomber jacket (white stripes around collar and sleeves) with school logo, or navy windcheater.

Boys Uniform

- Black shoes, these may be elastic sided boots, all black runners or traditional school shoes
- Sports shoes should be brought for PE and sport lessons

Summer:

- Navy shorts, navy track pants (double knee), navy short-sleeved polo shirt (white stripes around collar) with school logo.
- Navy windcheater with school logo.
- Bucket hat in terms 1 and 4

Winter:

- Navy track pants (double knee), navy long-sleeved polo shirt (white stripes around collar) with school logo.
- White or navy skivvy.
- Navy windcheater with school logo. Navy bomber jacket (white stripes around collar and sleeves) with school logo.

SECONDARY

Girls Uniform

Summer:

- Navy and white check dress /or/ navy school shorts with logo or navy tailored shorts and navy short-sleeved polo shirt (white stripes around collar) with school logo
- A pair of white or black sports socks, small navy, white or black logo or stripe acceptable, any length acceptable
- Black shoes
- Navy blue V-necked jumper or navy blue polar fleece jumper (Optional Murtoa College soft shell jacket)
- Optional VCE jumper/polo for Year 11 & 12 students (navy), Year 12 students may wear the Year 12 rugby top
- Bucket hat in terms 1 and 4

Winter:

- Pleated skirt, tailored navy pants, or navy track pants with school logo
- Navy short-sleeved polo shirt (white stripes around collar) with school logo. Navy blue V-necked jumper or navy blue polar fleece jumper
- Optional Murtoa College soft shell vest/jacket
- Optional VCE jumper and polo for Year 11 & 12 students. Year 12 students may wear the Year 12 rugby top
- Black shoes
- Navy tights or pantyhose, or white/black sports socks, small navy or black logo or stripe acceptable, any length acceptable
- Black or navy jackets may be worn to school and in the yard in Term 2 and Term 3

Boys Uniform

- Navy track pants with school logo
- White or black sports socks, small navy or black logo or stripe acceptable, any length acceptable
- Navy short-sleeved polo shirt (white stripes around collar) with school logo
- Navy blue V-necked jumper or navy blue polar fleece jumper
- Optional Murtoa College soft shell vest/jacket
- Black shoes
- Optional VCE jumper for Year 11 & 12 students (navy), Year 12 students may wear the Year 12 rugby top
- Bucket hat in terms 1 and 4
- No coats, hats, gloves or scarves to be worn in class

Sport & Physical Education Uniform - Unisex:

- Navy blue school polo top/ school volleyball top/ school football top or school sports singlet
- Navy sports shorts, may have white stripe
- Bucket hat in terms 1 and 4
- Navy tracksuit pants or navy or black leggings
- White or black socks
- Sports shoes with non-marking sole

**Please note if students wish to wear P.E. uniform to and from school on P.E. days it must be the school P.E. polo. Any student not in full P.E. uniform will be asked to change back to their standard uniform. (Volleyball hoodies, and shirts cannot be worn).*
